- a) Your nephew often sits in front of the old oak tree. (oak tree – Eiche)
~~Your nephew is often sitting in front of the old oak tree.~~
- b) Look, my finger bleeds.
 Look, my finger is bleeding. (to bleed – bluten)
- c) He lives in Manchester, but he works in Leeds at the moment.
 He lives in Manchester, but he is working in Leeds at the moment.
- d) What are you doing? – I feed my hamster.
 What are you doing? – I'm feeding my hamster.
- e) She listens to rap music every evening. (listen to music – Musik (an)hören)
 She is listening to rap music every evening.
- f) Peter always writes good English tests.
 Peter's always writing good English tests.
