

## The verb "have got" (1)

Add "have got" or "has got".  
Ergänze „have got“ oder „has got“.

**Example:** Charlie has got glue in his school bag.

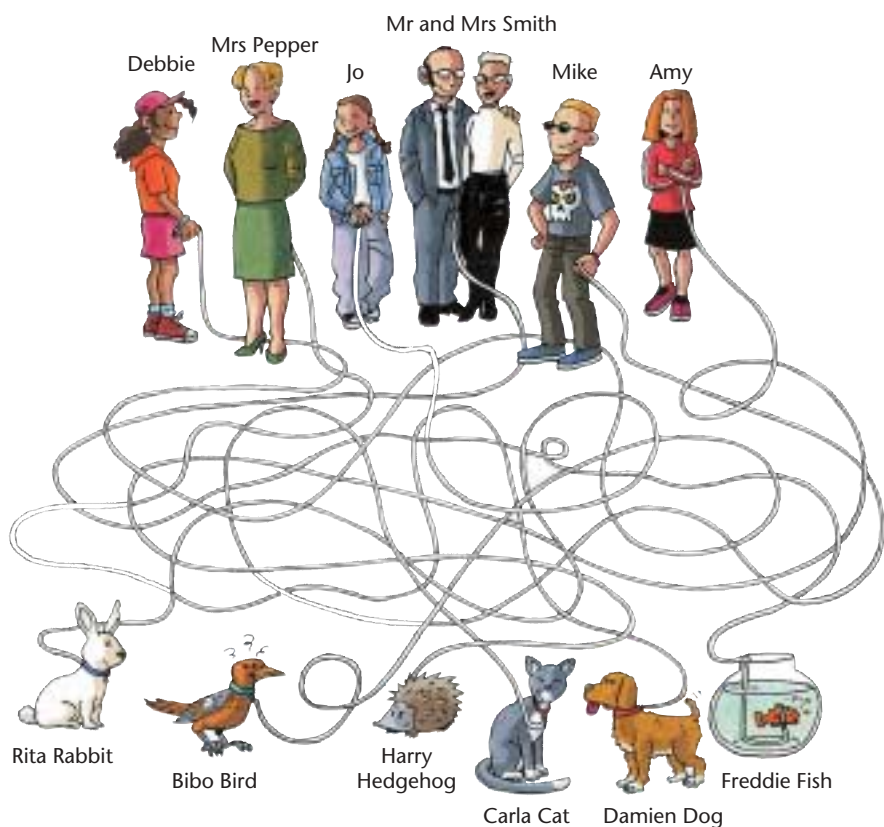


1. Caroline \_\_\_\_\_ many friends.
