3.2 America: the land of opportunity



THE AMERICAN DREAM

- → America as the "land of opportunity" → anyone who works hard enough can make their fortune
- > vision of a fair and equal society
- → "rags to riches" → made possible by new inventions and technological progress
- → reality today: the American Dream is not really achievable for most people → gap between rich and poor is too wide



THE MELTING POT

- → 1st 3 waves of immigrants: mainly from Europe; since 1930 → more from Central/South America and Asia
- "melting pot": new immigrants should be assimilated into American life to form a national identity
- society today: "salad bowl" or "mosaic" = separate parts make up a whole



MANIFEST DESTINY

- → America was destined by God create a great nation
- → pioneers settled in the west
 → spreading American values
- → belief in the greatness of America → defeat by Vietnam damaged pride
- → "make America great again" → exploitation of patriotic feelings



IMMIGRATION TODAY

- → no more "open door" policy → a limited number of visas and green cards are now issued
- > Issues with undocumented immigrants:
 - ightarrow they live in fear of deportation
 - → children born in the US are citizens: could be separated from deported parents
 - → belief that those who have lived in the US for a long time should be given citizenship
 - → many Republicans want stronger crackdowns on illegal immigrants and a significant reduction in immigration in general
