4.1 Lyrik (poetry)

STYLISTIC DEVICES

- → ... stylistic devices for imagery? Metaphor, metonymy, synecdoche, euphemism, hyperbole, hendiadys, oxymoron, paradoxon
- ... stylistic devices for repetition? Anapher, epipher, epanalepse, polyptoton, figura etymologica
- ... other stylistic devices? Alliteration, chiasm, onomatopoeia, personification

THE SPEAKER OF THE POEM

- the speaker of the poem: the voice, that actually tells the story of the poem
- the implicit speaker of the poem: indirect and suggestive, has to be assumed, does not appear
- → the explicit speaker of the poem: direct and clear, does appear

3 GUIDELINE QUESTIONS

- → Speaker related: Who is the speaker and who is being addressed? What or who is being contemplated or described? What is being explained, argued or told? What is the speaker's attitude?
- → Structure: How is the poem composed as in rhyme schemes, stanzas and such? Which poetic advices are used and to which effect? Is the sentence structure simple or complex? Is there a correspondence between the speaker's thoughts and the structure of the poem?
- → Effect: What is the meaning of the title? What is the overall effect? What does the reader experience?
